1. COME PLAY	Children grieve as much as adults do, but they often need a different language for expressing their grief: the language of play and art. This seminar presents tools for working with bereaved children and young people.		
2. GRIEF IN THE CLASSROOM	This workshop addresses the impact of bereavement on children & young people from a primary/post primary perspective. It also offers practical advice to guide teachers in responding to children and young people following a bereavement.		
3. PICKING UP THE PIECES	Bereavement support can be a complex journey for all concerned. In this workshop the impact on the relationships between parent, helper and bereaved child will be explored.		
4. FROM THE MOUTHS OF BABES	Bereavement for many young people is not just something to be suffered, but something from which others can learn. Come hear from young people sharing their experiences and explore activities and resources to help a range of age groups.		
5. ON THE FRONT LINES	Reaching into your community - helping clergy find a way through the maze of supporting young people's families & communities in the midst of grief.		
6. THE TANGLED WEB	Morning Session: The workshop will examine the pharmacology, properties and effects of 'ethanol' on the mind and body, with special emphasis on emotional health including self-harm and suicide.
