1. Application Guidelines

- 1. Applications will be welcome from any individual who seeks to become actively involved in mission either in Ireland or around the world. Parish Group Applications may also be made.
- 2. Applicants should be able to demonstrate active membership of the Church of Ireland and belong to a Parish within the Diocese of Connor.
- 3. Initial application should be by completing the attached 'Mission Support Fund Application Form'. All applications will be considered and a response made in writing. Applicants may be required to attend an interview.
- 4. Grants will be awarded to successful applicants by the 30th June each year. Applications should reach Connor Council for Mission by **Friday 20th May, 2016.**
- 5. Applicants will be required to provide Connor Council for Mission with a written reference from their Rector in support of their application. This should be enclosed (open or sealed) with the application form.
- 6. It must be clearly understood that the aim of the Fund is to make a percentage contribution towards the expense of the proposed mission activity. In no cases will the fund provide 100% of the estimated cost. In all cases the decision of Connor Council for Mission will be final.
- 7. All grants will be made by cheque made out in the name of the applicant. All applicants should ensure that they have an appropriate bank account to receive such a payment.
- 8. After completion of the proposed mission activity a short report shall be provided to Connor Council for Mission, including details of how the mission activity has benefitted the applicant, your home parish and the church where you have served.
