Game: Bowl Game



Purpose: This game has three rounds which get your group guessing and explaining the names of famous people!

First get everyone in your group to write down a name of a famous person, if you want the game to be longer you can each write down two or three names each.

Everyone pops their names into a bowl and divide the group into two teams.

Round 1

Choose a team to start, they will send up a representative who has 1 minute to describe as many of the names as possible. The rest of their team have to guess who they are describing. They can only pass once. They can use as many words as they like except for the actual name of the person. Each team alternates getting 1 minute to play until all the names are used up.

Round 2

For this round, each representative gets one minute to act out the famous person with their team guessing. It should be slightly easier as you've been through all the names once.

Round 3

Each representative can only say 1 word to explain their famous person. Again only one pass, so you must choose the word wisely!

Total up the scores at the end of each minute to give you a winner for the end!
