

DOWN & DROMORE AND CONNOR ORGAN SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

CONDITIONS

- 1 The Scholarship will be awarded for three years at the discretion of the Management Board following interview and competitive auditions. Tutors report to the Board on their scholars' progress twice a year. Scholars are expected to attend an annual assessment in June. The Board may withdraw the scholarship if reports of attendance or general progress are unsatisfactory.
- 2 A year's course will consist of approximately twenty lessons, each of an hour's duration, at approximately fortnightly intervals. Scholars are expected to practise and to prepare for lessons in the intervals between them.
- 3 The scholarship will cover the full cost of tuition, but the scholar will be expected to pay for such music as the tutor may recommend.
- 4 Scholars are expected, as an integral part of the course, to attend choir-training sessions three times a year, and to play at church services where appropriate.
- 5 Scholars will undertake to complete the course in three consecutive years.
- 6 A scholar who ceases to be involved in the music of the Church of Ireland, or who is unable to complete three consecutive years, will resign the scholarship, unless the Board gives express permission to continue.
