Our purpose

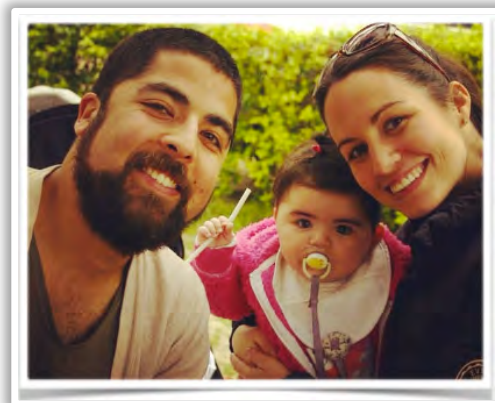
On 15th March 2016, Revd Jonny and Bishop Ken (Fanta) Clarke will travel to Santiago, Chile with SAMS (South America Mission Society). The time spent there will be very short, lasting only 1 week. The purpose of the trip is to understand and develop stronger links with our new partner Church, Santiago Apóstol. Through the SAMS Intern Programme, we as a parish built a new relationship with Rocio Castro Bravo. Rocio's home church is La Trinidad, and it is through La Trinidad that Pastor Cristóbal Cerón was set to plant an Anglican church in Santiago city centre in order to reach students, young professionals and others. Cristóbal and Assistant Pastor Max Diaz already have healthy links with SAMS, and the hope is through St Patrick's we can create a long lasting partnership by awareness of their context, prayer for their needs, provision for their ministry and equipping teams to both go to South America and come to Jordanstown.

Whilst in Chile, Fanta and Jonny will also attend the consecration of 2 new Bishops, one of which has family links with our new partner church.

Friday 18 th March	- Tour and discussion on the ministries that Cristóbal & Max are involved in within the University. - Discussions around next steps in developing the partnership between St Patrick's & Iglesia Santiago Apóstol.
Saturday 19 th March	Consecration Service of Bishops
Sunday 20 th March	Jonny teaching in Iglesia Santiago Church
Monday 21 st March	Ken & Jonny will begin the journey home, arriving in Dublin on Tuesday 22 nd March
