




Yinka Oyekan THE TURNING

In each episode of Sacred Harmony, we'll enjoy an insightful reflection from the Very Revd John Mann. He shares on encountering Christ each day in episode one:

One of the psalms speaks of the author's desire that he may have the wings of a dove to be able to fly away and be at rest. It is a longing to shed problems and anxieties to be at peace. This need to escape, what threatens one's emotional and mental equilibrium, is something that we can all to some extent understand, but the Christian of St Patrick's day possessed a more robust outlook on God's mercy and protection.

What threatened was also what inspired; what was awesome, brought one closer to Christ; as he was in the world and he was human, like us, but also beyond us and divine. At each turn in the path of life, the Celtic Christian was drawn further into the reality

of nature's power and beauty, rather than take them to a place where they could not be touched by insecurity and danger.

If prayer results from our contemplation of the heavens and the earth; from the sinuous movement of a fish in a placid stream, to the breeze waving the grass of a hay meadow or the sound of the lowing of a cow or the sight of the flight of a bird, then prayer becomes as natural as breathing, and as constant as time itself. Into such a world of faith we can, following the way of St Patrick himself, encounter Christ day by day.

Autumn is revealing itself in nature's colours, and the season of change spurs thoughts about change in our own lives.

I'm convinced that being open to God's sovereignty means being open to change. When we're not willing to accept or believe for change, we're simultaneously not accepting of, or believing that God's plans and ways are above our own.

In the Bible we meet David, who's definitely seen some change in life! We see him as the underestimated shepherd boy, giant-slayer, a musician, a valued member of the King's court, a target threatened with death, an adulterer, a King, and a sign post to Jesus! Reflecting on God's hand over his journey, he pours out in Psalm 40:

I waited patiently for the LORD; He turned to me and heard my cry. He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; He set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear the Lord and put their trust in him. Blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, who does not look to the proud, to those who turn aside to false gods.


